This season the Lab/Works series focuses on theatre-in-the-making, offering several rehearsed readings, a reading of a play in development, and a workshop performance of a new work.

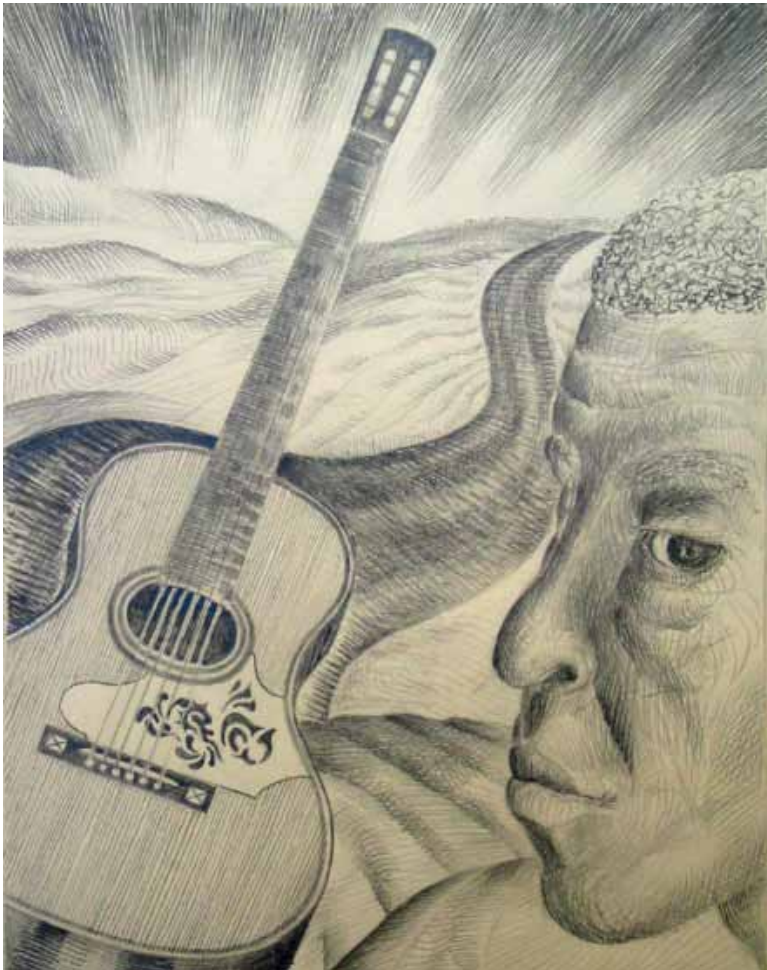

The set includes drops created by UWM art students under the guidance of Milwaukee artist Raoul Deal, and images made by students at Hartford University School detailing their own journeys to the gateway city of Milwaukee.
